Points of Interest:

• <u>Non-covered Services</u>: still alive, but still in committee. Legislature sluggish due to ongoing investigation of Speaker DeLeo and because Deval is essentially a lame duck and all are waiting to see whose hats are in the ring for next governor.

- <u>BORID</u>: Dr. Mina Paul has retired but there have been two great additions to the Board of Registration recently: Dr. Milt Glicksman and Dr. David Samuels, both past presidents of the MDS. This is good news.
- Chapter 224 (Health Care Cost Containment):
 - o Electronic Health Records (EHR) will be mandatory in 2017.
 - o For dentistry, there is still not clarity. So buyer beware if you are buying new software...not all dental software is going to pass muster with the Affordable Care Act, etc, even though vendor may tell you that it will be no-problem-seamless integration.
 - o In future, both Medicaid and Exchange (conventional insurance) plans will endeavor to pay dentists based on quality and measurable outcomes. This is not yet defined. But we better stay tuned. What this may mean for your income and your practice future is undetermined.

<u>ACA</u>: the affordable care act is on our doorstep. We will see significant positive changes for pediatric patient benefits from both Mass Health and Exchange Plans (like Delta, BCBS and all the rest). Likely no immediate changes for adults. It is not determined. Some have concerns that many adults may <u>drop</u> coverage on themselves once they have coverage for their kids that is paid for by Uncle Sam.

• <u>Health Care Summit</u> back in June was a success. 200 dentists, insurance industry experts, and health care future-thinkers convened and discussed how we prepare for the future now.

- Botox is now legal for dentists to administer to their patients after taking an eight-hour course.
- There is a "Virtual Gateway" available to dentists' prescribing Schedule 2 medications. This is a database which contains a patients past use of these medications. Registered Dentists can access this database to monitor their patients use of Schedule 2 medications from all prescribers.

Items from the Floor:

Dr. Michael Wasserman stated that the Affordable Care Act will require dentists' to notify their employees about health insurance availability or potentially face a \$100/day fine. All Massachusetts employers with more than \$500,000 in annual revenue, regardless of size, are required to issue a notification to your current employees about the Massachusetts Health Connector by October 1, 2013. This notification applies to all of your employees regardless of whether they are employed full-time or part-time with the practice. This notification requirement is for all employers for whom the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) applies. Moving forward, employers are also required to provide notification about the Massachusetts Health Connector to all new hires within 14 days of the employee's start date. A suitable form is available for download at www.massdental.org in the "For Professionals Tab".
